Main duties and responsibilities

- Assess and underwrite bridging and development loan applications in line with prevailing lending policy and mandate level
- Assess and resolve risk or any issues with applications
- Work closely with intermediaries to manage the process from application to completion
- Assess credit reports, KYC and AML documentation to ensure applications are verified
- Review valuation reports
- Approve and reject applications in line with policy and mandate
- Recommend loans to the Head of Lending or Credit Committee where they fall outside of the lending mandate held
- Produce high-quality and articulate credit papers, presenting a clear rationale for supporting the proposal
- Manage your own pipeline of cases
- Liaising with brokers, borrowers and professional partners such as solicitors and surveyors
